From the Pastor...

What Are the Chances?...

Well, by the time you're reading this, I'll be on my sabbatical. It seems rather surreal to me to have this time to write, reflect, travel and just be. I am so grateful!

I wasn't sure what to share with you until I had a recent "Godcidence"...you know, a coincidence that really isn't a coincidence at all but rather God's hand working in God's timing.

What I'm about to share might seem like a small thing...but that's part of the point. I believe God cares about the minute details of our lives as well as the sweeping hugeness of what's going on in the world. We are told in scripture that God knows every hair on our head.

On Saturday, April 6, (one week and one day before my sabbatical was to begin) I was in a bit of a funk. I couldn't really identify it right away, but there was a heaviness within me. I was thinking things like, "I should be getting excited about my upcoming time to write and travel, see family and friends"; however, I was feeling low and questioning my even going on sabbatical. "Who am I to think I can write a book?" "Who am I to leave home for weeks at a time?" "What am I doing?" "Is this God's plan for me or just an idea I came up with?" All of this and more was racing through my mind. Several times that day, Warren asked me what was wrong, and I'd just reply with an "I'm just tired." At that point in time, I couldn't really identify my feelings or where all this was coming from.

Sunday morning, April 7, I got up, still feeling a bit down, which is very unusual, especially on a Sunday morning. I LOVE Sunday mornings...and Monday mornings and Tuesday mornings...I tend to be a morning person. Morning is when I sit on the porch in my bentwood rocker, sipping hot coffee with candles lit,

reading devotionals, journaling, and just having my quiet time with God. It is such a blessing to have the time to start the day in this way. But on that Sunday, I woke up still feeling tired and just kind of blah. I went to the porch with coffee in hand and just sat there for a while, thinking about the day before and wondering why I'm feeling this way. Eventually, I started reading my devotionals. One of them (I forget which one) pointed out that when we're struggling with something within ourselves sometimes it is from God and sometimes it is from the opposite of God, the evil one, satan, the great deceiver or whatever you want to call that negative force that puts doubts in our minds. Then, I read the devotion from the Upper Room, and it began like this, "I am in the process of publishing my first book..." The words just jumped out at me. What are the chances of me reading this on that particular day after spending the day before doubting my call to write. For me, both of these readings were affirmations for my whole time of sabbatical. I don't really know how to explain it, but the fog lifted from my spirit, and I felt like me again.

I just wanted to share this because I realize I have a lot of these "what are the chances" moments in my life...these "Godcidences"...and I bet if you think about it, you do too. What a comfort to know that God is in the small stuff, the medium stuff, the large and enormous stuff of our lives.

Now the only "mixed feeling" I have is that I will miss all of you. I will miss being with you. I will miss working with you. I will miss worshiping with you. But I'm excited for this opportunity and I'm sure I'll have lots to share upon my return.


It is our plan to move to the Baptist Meeting House the 2nd week in June (6/9).

Church Bell Repair

The trustees are happy to report that the windlass or wooden wheel has been rebuilt and installed on the bell in the Baptist Meeting House. This allows the bell to be rung manually with a rope that will extend down into the closet adjacent to the narthex. This is the first time, we think, in over 40 years, that the bell can be rung with the rope. Plans for the future include arranging so the bell can be rung automatically on designated hours of the day.
