


The Book Group will be starting the book "Imagine Heaven" by John Burke on September 16.





"The Armor of God" will be the new sermon series that begins on Sunday September 1 and will run through the entire month. This series will be based on Priscilla Shirer's study guide entitled, "The Armor of God" which covers Ephesians 6:10-18. For these five weeks, a special guest will be joining us. Pumpkin Time Is Here

In October, we hope to offer pumpkin carving for the pumpkin display at the Remick Park and to hand out candy for the Sandwich School Parade and for Halloween evening Trick or Treaters. The specific days and times of these events will be forthcoming.

Baptist Meetinghouse Steeple Update:



We had hoped to report good news regarding the steeple; however, the steeple will need to come down. Our contractor, Tony Hibbard from New England Church Restoration, preparing to remove the metal on the steeple and install a new material that would require little maintenance for many years to come, and discovered rot in various areas of the spire. Upon inspection of the base of the steeple, he uncovered extensive rot in the support timbers in the area immediately below the steeple and behind the area between the top of the bell area and the base of the steeple. This area is the section behind where the white circles are located. To confirm Tony's concerns,

Stan Graton of Stan Graton II 3G Construction Inc., a renowned covered bridge builder and historic building renovator, was contacted for a second opinion. Stan inspected the steeple and reported we had a serious safety issue, and in his opinion, the steeple needed to be removed as soon as possible. Both Tony and Stan agreed completely on the best course of action, which is to remove the steeple and secure the top for winter to protect it from further damage. We are in touch with our insurance company, Church Mutual, to see about coverage for repairing this damage. The cost to repair is unknown as further evaluation is needed to determine the replacement cost. This problem developed over time with no visible evidence of any deterioration in the support timbers, and it is a blessing it was discovered before it became a safety issue. Rest assured; our steeple will be restored to its former elegance. We will continue to keep you posted on the progress.







<u>NEW Railings!</u> You may, or may not, have noticed (because it feels like they have always been there!) the new railings at lower-level entrances to the Baptist and Methodist Meetinghouses. Up until July 2024, only one side of the stairs had a railing. Thanks to Mike Amato of Whittier Welding (Sandwich) both sides of the stairs now have a railing. ~ Board of trustees

<u>Dishwasher:</u> The new dishwasher has been installed at the MMH. Thank you to Tony Gasbarro for bringing this project to light and thank you to the trustees for following this through to completion. Our hope is that it will get lots of use in serving the community.
